# GUEST SPEAKERS



Peter received his undergraduate dental degree from Trinity College Dublin. He worked in general dental practice and hospital based practice prior to obtaining his clinical doctorate in periodontology, also from TCD, in 2009. He served as a clinical assistant professor and pre-doctoral program director in periodontology at University of Florida from 2010 - 2014. He currently works as a lecturer in periodontology at DDUH. In addition to didactic and clinical teaching across the dental programme, his direct responsibilities include provision of pre-clinical teaching in periodontology. He also contributes to teaching on the postgraduate programme in periodontology at DDUH, in addition to undertaking further studies towards a PhD. Peter is a member of the postgraduate education committee of the European Federation of Periodontology. He is currently president of the Irish Society of Periodontology.

**DR PETER HARRISON**



David received his B.A. (Mod.), Ph.D. and Sc.D. from Trinity College Dublin. Joining the School of Dental Science in 1989, he is now Professor of Oral and Applied Microbiology and Head of the division of Oral Biosciences. He is a Fellow of Trinity and the Royal College of Pathologists London, member of the Royal Irish Academy and winner of the RIA silver medal for Microbiology. Published in 225+ articles in peer-reviewed international journals and books, his research interests focus on translational microbiology including automated minimisation of infection risks from water networks and medical devices, and the population biology, evolution, genomics and antibiotic resistance mechanisms of methicillin resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA), other staphylococci and pathogenic *Candida* species.

**DAVID COLEMAN**



Juliette Reeves is a dental hygienist and trained nutritionist with over thirty years experience. She has written and lectured internationally over the last eighteen years on the systemic associations between nutrition and oral health with a particular focus on chronic inflammation. She is a Key Opinion Leader to Philips Oral Healthcare, Biogaia and Clinical Director of Perio- Nutrition. Juliette is an elected council member to the British Society of Dental Hygiene and Therapy and a member of the BSDHT Education Committee. As a practicing hygienist, her main areas of interest are salivary diagnostics, oral health of the renal patient and nutritional influences in chronic inflammation and periodontal disease. Juliette regularly provides post-graduate training courses internationally and in the UK and received a lifetime achievement award for Outstanding Contribution to Dental Hygiene and Therapy in 2014.
